PERMISSION to LEAVE CAMPUS

FOR STUDENTS ENROLLED IN "2019-2020" JCTC 1 1th Grade College Core

Students enrolled in the Junior College Core Program at Oldham County High School are extended the privilege of leaving campus on the days on which the classes do not meet or occasional days where class has been cancelled. The privilege to leave campus is limited to the same time during which the course meets on class days. In order to exercise this privilege, students must be a junior with an A/B average, must have parent/guardian permission, and must sign-in and sign-out with the attendance clerk. The student must be wearing their college lanyard in order to sign in or out of campus. In addition, there may be days students are asked to come in on their off days. Failure to comply or follow these rules could result in losing the privilege to leave campus.

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I give my permission for my son/daughter (name), _____, who is enrolled in college courses at Oldham County High School, to be dismissed from school and leave campus on Monday/ Wednesday & occasional day where class has been cancelled. I understand that during these times, if my son/daughter leaves campus, he or she will not be under the supervision, custody or control of Oldham County High School or the Oldham County Board of Education. My student has his/her own transportation and isn't allowed to ride with or transport another student during non-college time. I may revoke this consent at any time by contacting the administration at Oldham County High School in writing. In addition, this consent will automatically be revoked if my child drops out of the college course in which he or she is participating. The administrators at Oldham County High School may revoke this consent if deemed necessary for the safety or well-being of my child, or as a result of a disciplinary action. I agree to provide my day-time phone number and my child's phone number in case of an emergency that requires the school to contact me or my child.

I have read the above information, understand it, and my signature below indicates consent to all of the above. In consideration of the advantages to my child in exercising this privilege, to the extent allowable by law, I hereby release and hold harmless the Oldham County Board of Education, its members, employees, agents, representatives and insurers, and Oldham County High School and its employees and agents, from any liability for bodily injury or death.
